Re: HIV Testing for Patients ≤ 2 Years of Age

Effective immediately, the North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) will begin sending clinical specimens from patients ≤ 2 years of age who require Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) testing to LabCorp. LabCorp results will be attached to NCSLPH reports in the NCSLPH Clinical and Environmental Lab Results (CELR) online portal and included in paper results sent via the State courier. This NCSLPH-provided testing will be for HIV RNA NAAT only. Additional testing may be required based on individual patient clinical information to ensure appropriate case management.
